## About the Performers:

**LISA GREENLEAF** from Boston, MA, is a valued leader at dance camps and festivals, both nationally and abroad. Lisa is known for her rich repertoire, succinct and witty teaching, and infectious commitment to community building. She's also known for calling good dances every time.

From his home in Sharon, VT, **JEREMIAH McLANE** has traveled throughout the US and Europe as a performer and teacher. He is widely regarded as one of the most talented accordionists in the country, performing and recording with **THE CLAYFOOT STRUTTERS**, **BIG TABLE**, fiddler **RUTHIE DORNFELD** and the acclaimed trio **NIGHTINGALE**, on both accordion and piano.

**MARK ROBERTS** has long pursued Irish flute and old-time banjo with equal passion. An alumnus of Triona Ni Domnaill's award-winning group **TOUCHSTONE**, he has in recent years toured worldwide with the **RED CLAY RAMBLERS**. Currently living in the Pacific Northwest, he commutes eastward for groove-based dance band projects including the **CLAYFOOT STRUTTERS** and **THE SEVENS**.

Vermont fiddler and guitarist **PETE SUTHERLAND**'s fine compositions have become standards of the modern folk repertoire through his performances with such groups as **METAMORA**, **RHYTHM IN SHOES**, **IRA BERNSTEIN**, Mac Benford's **WOODSHED ALL-STARS**, and **THE CLAYFOOT STRUTTERS**, as well as on countless recordings and public radio broadcasts.
